

"Welcome to the Pack" PUPPY PACK INVITATION

In 2017 Wests Rugby will be continuing our successful "Puppy Pack" program in its Junior Rugby Union Pathways Plan. The BJRU promotes Pathways as its program for Boys & Girls from Under 6 and upwards to learn the basic skills of Rugby right up until the Player can play Senior Rugby.

Wests encourages Boys & Girls aged 3 to 5 years of age to come to Wests training on Friday nights. Children must be a minimum of 3 years of age. Alternatively children that have had 5 year old birthday in 2017 can play rugby in the under 6 teams.

The Puppy Pack concept allows children under supervision to be active, learn various ball skills and have fun with new friends while being involved in a Junior Club atmosphere. After 1 or 2 years of this program the child will have a better understanding when they take on their first year of official junior rugby in under 6.

The Club will provide trainers to run the program from 5.00pm – 6.00pm on Friday night to look after and nurture these Boys & Girls. Senior Players and Parents will also be encouraged to join in and assist where needed. Our Designated Trainers all have a Blue Cards. The Child's Welfare and Wellbeing is paramount to the Club.

The fee for the Puppy Pack is \$150 for the season. The season starts on the 24th February and goes through until the middle of August. The program will not operate in school holidays as there is no training on these Friday nights. The fee will include a new Bulldogs T Shirt, Bulldogs sticker, water bottle, entry to all rides at our Break Up Party, and a Puppy Pack Medal.

Children should wear shoes & training T Shirt and a parent or guardian MUST be nearby.
